April 17, 2017

PREVIOUS

MEETING: A motion was made by Hackenberg, supported by Schuur, to accept the minutes of the March 27, 2017 Board Workshop Meeting as presented. Roll call vote. 6 Ayes, 0 Nays. Motion Carried.

ACCOUNTS

PAYABLE: A motion by Engstrom, supported by Hackenberg, to approve the accounts payable for payment in the amount of \$167,901.15. Roll call vote. 6 Ayes, 0 Nays. Motion Carried.

ADMINISTRATOR

REPORTS: Elementary Principal Mindy Bohan reported they started the M-Step testing last week. The elementary had an Easter egg hunt on Thursday, April 13th. Kindergarten Round-Up will be held Wednesday, April 19th at 6:00 p.m. Next year the 5<sup>th</sup> grade students will be adopting a bookshelf in the elementary library that they will be responsible for maintaining.

Middle/High School Principal Lynn Wagner reported they tested students all last week, and the 8<sup>th</sup> grade students will have M-Step testing this week. 7<sup>th</sup> grade M-Step testing will be the week of May 1<sup>st</sup>. Principal Wagner will be attending a special education conference on Tuesday, April 18<sup>th</sup>. There are three students that were recognized for Academic All-Conference, they are Tanner Bohan, Grace Voege and Jade Sibley. Teacher appreciation is May 1<sup>st</sup> – 5<sup>th</sup>. The Junior/Senior Prom will be held on May 13<sup>th</sup>. Friday, April 21<sup>st</sup> the 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade girls will be attending a “Girls Can Workshop”. She also announced that new benches have been placed in front of the MS/HS building.

Amy Anderson reported that students will have a Career Day in May. Students will be taking a trip to Notre Dame in the next 2 weeks. ETS will be taking the students to Eberhardt Camp.

Transportation/Operations Director Brad Russell reported that over spring break there was work done on the sidewalk, stage, ES flooring and that 3 or 4 coats of wax has been applied to the new flooring. The new bleachers for the auxiliary gym will be delivered next Monday, and installed by the end of the week. The new benches are in. There are only a few items left on the punch list. Brad also reported this is a busy time for transportation due to sports and field trips.

Superintendent Pauley report noted that Tony Leninger of the Carmi Group will be working with our district on our track replacement project. He will likely have quotes for preliminary work sometime this week. He will move forward with bidding documents over the next couple of months and should be ready to bid in November.
