



*Keystone is the HARA for St. Joseph County. Keystone screens people and places into the homeless management system (Prevention) and get the appropriate referral.

**State Emergency Relief for bill utility payment has an annual maximum. Must have shut off notice to access services. Income &asset qualifications apply.

*** Salvation Army utility assistance must have shut off notice or a past due notice. Limited by annual cap

**** Salvation Army Emergency Food requires State ID for everyone over 18, and Social Security Cards for entire household

*****State Emergency Relief for mortgage or rent payment has an annual maximum. Must have court ordered eviction notice or foreclosure notice to access services. Income and asset qualifications apply.

*******Utility help one time per year per household in St Joseph County MI. Must have the following: Decline letter from DHHS (proving they tried Michigan Emergency Relief Fund first), shut off notice, a picture ID, the bill MUST be in their name. UCAP does NOT pay if the entire bill will not be paid. UCAP does NOT pay for down payments if the utility has already been turned off or hook up fees.

*******Must have a picture ID showing address is in St Joseph County MI. One voucher to Three Rivers Hardings only, every three months

******* The Constantine Church Association is made up of Messiah Lutheran Church, Trinity Missionary Church,1st Congregational UCC, and United Methodist Church. Services are distributed through Messiah Lutheran Church, 185 W. 5th Thursday, 9a-11a. Must be a resident of Constantine School District to receive assistance

Warming/ Cooling Centers are heated or cooled facilities where people may go for relief during temporary periods of extreme cold or heat. These facilities provide water and restrooms.



** Keystone Place from time to time will turn out clients from shelter due to disruptive or violent behavior. Illegal behavior is reported **and handled by law enforcement. Disruptive behavior that does not bring harm to others is given a warning without client being turned out of shelter. Behavior placing others at risk will result in client being turned out of shelter Shelter staff will assist client to find other shelter either with client's family or another shelter by the end of the day. Since Keystone is the only homeless shelter in county, arrangements are made with another shelter out of county. This may be an inconvenience to the client who may be working in county and have transportation issues, but protecting children in the shelter is Keystone's priority.

Keystone staff, legally, is not permitted to talk to anyone about a client's housing situation or actions that led them to be turned out without a release of information. If a group is working with the client to help find them shelter and is looking for details why client was released, a signed release of information must give permission for staff to discuss the clients situation and why the client was turned out. Release forms can be faxed to the shelter at 269 467-7742. Due to HIPAA regulations, Keystone staff cannot discuss client's mental or physical health with anyone.

When families with children are turned out of Keystone Place, and staff is concerned for child's well-being, the family will be reported to Child Protective Services.
