Last night, Governor Whitmer ordered a state-wide closure of all schools in the state beginning Monday, March 16, 2020 through April 5, 2020. Our district will have spring break during the week of April 6, 2020. Barring any additional mandates from the state, we anticipate returning to school on Monday, April 13, 2020.

Our administration has worked this week to identify different ways we can support our students in order to continue the educational process during this time away from the school building. We are providing multiple avenues for our students to continue learning even when they are away from the classroom. We understand this process is new for everyone and we will work together to do what is best for our students.

We recognize that all families do not have internet connectivity, therefore the education of our students is dependent on our entire community. Our administrative team is working to develop a system by which your student will receive assignments and other necessary educational materials. Transitioning learning from the building to home is new for all of us and we will work through it together.

Along with providing access to online learning links, our students will have access to teachers' lesson plans, assignments, and links to various educational platforms through PowerSchool and Google Classroom that they can complete at home.
